Colby took two star studded squads to Holt RFC to take part in the NNSP Rugby Championship. After a quick lunch, the squads went to their separate pitches to prepare for their first games. Colby A were playing Holt and scored with their first play. They then produced one of the most aggressive and well disciplined defensive displays ever witnessed. Their Blitz attacking line overwhelmed their opponents and they ran out comfortable 8-0 winners. Alfie and George were able to implement the Blitz attack superbly, enabling the rest of the team to pick up the tactics.
