It would be fantastic to see as many Colby children as can make it there again this Sunday. Mr B and Hannah




Amber and Sapphire Nativity

Christmas Party Food Lunch – Thursday 19th December 2024

We reinstated the epic Christmas Party Food Lunch last year and it was a great success! So, it's back by popular demand again on Thursday 19th December 2024 and we hope you will all want to take part.

Children in Amber and Sapphire Class (and children in Key Stage 2 who are entitled to free school meals) will be provided with a lunch of pizza and salad on Thursday 19th December 2024 – their entitlement to a free meal. However, we hope you will help us have a wonderful Christmas Party Lunch by sending in some additional food so we can have a party buffet together in the school hall.

Key Stage 2 children are invited to send in food for the Christmas Party Food Lunch too. Colby Kitchen will not be providing hot meals for Key Stage 2 on this day (other than those children who are entitled to free school meals).

The chart below lists the food item that we would like you to provide for the Christmas Party Food buffet. It looks more complicated than it is – simply find your child's year group and the letter that starts their surname to find out what food they should bring in. For example: Harry **P**otter in **Year 6** would bring **crisps**.

Please cater for around 8 children – you don't need to provide a whole feast. If you could send the food in a disposable container, that would be very helpful. Otherwise, please label any box clearly so we can return it to you afterwards.

If your child has food allergies, you may prefer to send them with a plate of their own party food. Please contact me if you would like to discuss how we can help your child enjoy the buffet safely.

Please send your party food donation in on morning of Thursday 19th December 2024.

Any wrapped donations (crisps, wrapped biscuits, wrapped cakes) which are left over (if anything is) will be donated to a Christmas Food Bank.

If you would prefer your Amber or Sapphire Class child just to have their pizza lunch that day, please let me know. There is no pressure for children to be involved but we may need to reallocate food donations if children opt out. Key Stage 2 children can choose to bring a packed lunch instead but, again, it would be helpful if you could let me know in advance so I can ensure we have enough food to go around.
